Sponsorship Levels

- **» Garden (\$500):** Promotion through ANCA's Bike the Barns webpage, electronic communications leading up to the event, and social media; logo on event signage; logo BikeADK's event page
- » Field (\$750): Garden Level benefits plus one complimentary registration <u>or</u> sponsor table, <u>and</u> one meal and beverage, at finish-line celebration
